The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioners Meeting Room at the Lafayette County Courthouse in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Mason Byrd, Dist. 2; Commissioner Lisa Walker, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

SPECIAL ASSESSMENT POLICY FOR CAMPGROUNDS

The Board continued discussion on the Special Assessment Policy as it relates to campgrounds. After a brief discussion, review of the proposed fee schedule, and discussion with representatives from the Suwannee River Rendezvous, on a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to charge one special assessment for every 10 campsites, for all campgrounds.

DISCUSS RAISING IMPACT FEES FOR THE COUNTY

The Board continued discussing raising impact fees for the County on all new construction. On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to table this to the next meeting so that the County Attorney can research the percentage amount that an impact fee can be raised from its current price.

DISCUSS CHANGING THE BOARD MEETING DAY FROM MONDAY TO TUESDAY

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to change the Board meeting day from the second and fourth Monday of

each month to the second and fourth Tuesday, but to keep the times of the meeting the same.

DISCUSS THE "JAKE BRAKING" ISSUE IN DAY

The Board discussed the "Jake Braking" issue in Day, as brought before the Board by Commissioner Lamb. On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to table this issue to allow Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson to research this and to draft a proposed Ordinance for the Board to adopt.

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Adams, the Board voted unanimously to approve the following bills:


- General Fund - \$72,624.49
