The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioners Meeting Room at the Lafayette County Courthouse in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Mason Byrd, Dist. 2; Commissioner Lisa Walker, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

PEGGY GRILL – CITIZEN REQUEST TO GRADE ROAD

Peggy Grill addressed the Board with a request to grade her road, NE Trestle Drive. She submitted a signed petition from the 10 residents that live on that road to the Board, 4 of which live there permanently. On a motion by Mrs. Walker and a second by Mr. Byrd, the Board voted unanimously to approve the request to grade the road.

REQUEST TO ADVERTISE FOR CEMETERY MOWING

On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve a request from Scott Sadler, Public Works Director, to advertise for the Cemetery Mowing.

RAISING IMPACT FEES

The Board discussed the possibility of raising impact fees for the County. On a motion by Mr. Byrd and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted the following way: Lamb – yes; Byrd – yes; Walker – yes; Adams – no; Jones – yes, to have Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson draft an Ordinance that would raise the impact fee to \$450.00 over 4 years, and to advertise for approval at a later meeting.

ACCEPT RESIGNATION LETTER OF THE VETERANS SERVICE OFFICER

On a motion by Mr. Adams and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to accept the resignation of the Veterans Service Officer, Christy Hamlin.

REQUEST TO USE THE MAYO COMMUNITY CENTER AT NO CHARGE

Cathy Musgrave requested use of the Mayo Community Center 3-4 times per year at no charge to hand out clothes and various donations to the community. Upon general consent, the Board approved her request.





RE: CR 53 Construction Engineering Inspection (CEI) Services

Dear Mr. Land,

Volkert, Inc. appreciates the opportunity to submit this proposal for CR 53 resurfacing project Professional CEI Services. The project begins at the intersection with US 27 and continues north 9.1 miles to the Madison County Line, just south of SR 51. This 98-day original construction contract time job is a FDOT funded project with preliminary plans showing work primarily consisting of milling and resurfacing, guardrail replacement, new bridge joint material, drainage pipe end wall replacements with concrete mitered ends, turnout reconstruction, pavement markings, signs, and grassing.

SCOPE OF CEI SERVICES

Volkert will provide CEI services that include:

1. Conduct site visits and progress meetings with authorized County representatives and Contractor personnel throughout the life of the project.
2. Schedule and conduct a preconstruction meeting with contractor and other stakeholders to review contract and plan required specified requirements, verify contractor's operation schedules, discuss safety items and potential construction issues.
3. Provide full-time on-site construction inspection to ensure work is performed in accordance with plans provided by the Design Engineer of Record (EOR), James H. Pittman, Jr, PE, North Florida Professional Services, Inc. and cited specifications. If site conditions dictate deviations from original design, coordinate changes through the EOR.
4. Produce Daily documentation reports of on-site construction activities, including pay items completed, weather conditions, Maintenance of Traffic operations, personnel and equipment used.
5. Review and verify Contractor progress payment requests and final payment.
6. Produce monthly progress summaries which will accompany recommendations for contractor's progress payments.
7. Coordinate FDOT inspection review prior to final acceptance and punch list completion (Volkert will produce a punch list).
8. Provide a Certification of completion and final payment.
9. Assist the Lafayette County Clerk's Office with FDOT local program project monitoring status reports.

Total Proposed Fee: \$150,000
