

REORGANIZATION MEETING
NOVEMBER 12, 2019
9:00 A.M.

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The annual reorganization meeting of the Lafayette County Board of County Commissioners was held on November 12, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. with the following members present: Henry McCray, Dist. 2; Lisa Walker, Dist. 3; Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

The meeting was called to order by Steve Land, Clerk of Court. The floor was opened for nominations for Chairman. Mr. Jones nominated Mr. Adams for Chairman and Mrs. Walker seconded the motion. On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mrs. Walker, the board voted unanimously for nominations to cease. The Board unanimously elected Mr. Adams as Chairman. The floor was opened for nominations for Vice-Chairman. Mr. Jones nominated Mr. Lamb and Mrs. Walker seconded the motion. On a motion by Mrs. Walker and a second by Mr. Jones, the board voted unanimously for nominations to cease. The Board unanimously elected Mr. Lamb as Vice-Chairman.

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to re-appoint all members to the committees on which they are currently serving. The following County Commissioners were appointed to the following Boards: North Florida Regional Planning Council – Anthony Adams; Economic Development – Henry McCray; Small County Coalition – Earnest Jones and Anthony Adams; Three Rivers Regional Library Board – Lance Lamb; Transportation Disadvantage Health Planning Council – Lisa Walker; and Task Force for the Suncoast Connection (proposed toll road) – Anthony Adams.

On a motion by Mr. McCray and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to re-hire all Department Heads which include the following – Scott Sadler as Public Works Director; Robert Hinkle as Building/Zoning Official; Marcus Calhoun as County Maintenance; Marty Tompkins as EMS Director; and Deborah Johnson as County Library Manager.

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to re-hire all Custodians which include the following: Alicia Swinson at the Day Community Center; Helen Bennett at the Airline Community Center and the Mayo

Community Center; Bonnie Adams at the Fourth District Community Center; and Tina Finch at the Courthouse and Extension Office.

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to re-hire all positions that are under the Department Heads.

On a motion by Mr. McCray and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to re-hire all Professional Services firms which include the following: Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson as County Attorney; Clemons Rutherford, Inc. as Construction and Project Architect; Jim Davis, CPA as County Auditor; and Robert Spindell, M.D. as EMS Medical Director.

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to continue the use of the 4 engineering firms that are currently on contract.

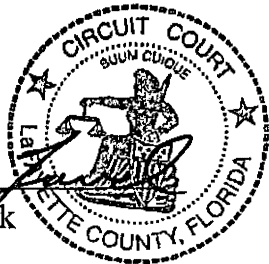
On a motion by Mr. McCray and a second by Mr. Jones, the board voted unanimously to adjourn.
