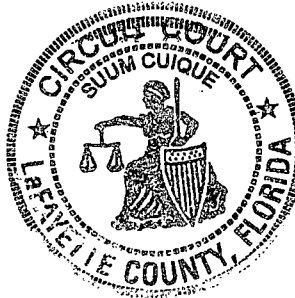
NOTICE OF FORECLOSURE SALE
