The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioners Meeting Room at the Lafayette County Courthouse in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Henry McCray, Dist. 2; Commissioner Lisa Walker, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

**OPEN THE PLANNING & ZONING BOARD MEETING**

**CONSIDER RESOLUTION NO. PZ/LPA LDR 22-02**

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to have Mrs. McMillan read Resolution No. PZ/LPA LDR 22-02 by title only. On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Resolution, as read, in regards to amending the Land Development Regulations to add a special exception for travel trailer parks not to exceed 20 sites in a rural, residential zoning district.

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn the Board of Adjustments meeting.

**APPROVE THE MINUTES**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

**OPEN SEALED BIDS FOR RE-ROOFING JOB AT THE HEALTH  
DEPARTMENT**

The Board opened the following bids for a partial re-roofing job at the Health Department: O'Neal Roofing - \$35,980.00; and Keeler Roofing - \$23,650.00. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to approve awarding the low bid, pending the review and approval of the Maintenance Department and the Building Department.

**REQUEST FOR PAYMENT OF SICK AND ANNUAL LEAVE**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to approve a request from the Road Department for payment of accumulated annual and sick leave time to Robert Heinz.

**REQUEST TO ADVERTISE FOR GARBAGE TRUCK OPERATOR**

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. McCray, the Board voted unanimously to approve advertising for a Garbage Truck Operator, with a starting salary of \$13.00 per hour.

**PUBLIC HEARING – FIRST READING OF AN ORDINANCE**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to have Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson read Ordinance No. 2022-03 by title only. This was the first reading of the Ordinance, the second reading will be held at the next Board Meeting.

**REQUEST FOR PAYMENT OF SICK LEAVE**

On a motion by Mr. McCray and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to approve a request from EMS to pay half of the accumulated sick leave for Curtis Young, who is retiring.

## **DOUBLEWIDE PORTABLE CLASSROOM AT THE EXTENSION OFFICE**

The Board discussed the Doublewide Portable Classroom located at the Extension Office, that they opened bids for at the last meeting. On a motion by Mr. McCray and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to accept the bid from the Lafayette Baseball Boosters in the amount of \$750.00, and then to donate that amount to them in return.

## **COUNTRY STRONG GYM REQUEST FOR IMPROVEMENTS**

The Board discussed the request from the Country Strong Gym, for improvements to their building at the Industrial Park. Commissioner McCray went to their building to discuss the work they needed to have done. On a motion by Mr. McCray and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to approve their request for painting and other improvements.

Special Account Grants Fund - \$751.40

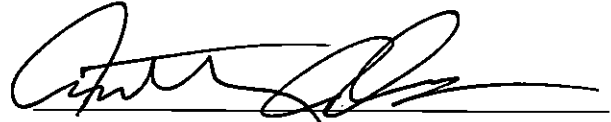
Courthouse Renovation/Construction Fund - \$5,947.80
