

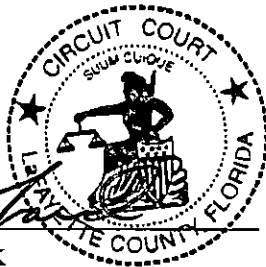
ADJOURN
