

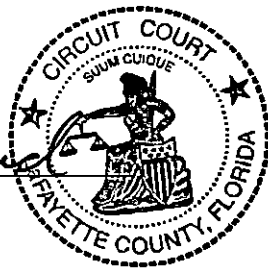
ADJOURN
