Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received at the Lafayette County Clerk's office, located in Lafayette County Courthouse, 120 West Main Street, Mayo, Florida until **3:00 PM on Friday, May 23, 2025** for The County **Invitation to Bid (ITB)**. Bids delivered to any other location will not be considered received by the Procurement Department. Any bids received after the above time will not be accepted under any circumstances. Any uncertainty regarding the time will be resolved against the Bidder. Bids will not be accepted via fax or electronic media. The Bid opening will occur as a scheduled agenda item of the Board of County Commissioners, at their meeting which starts at **5:30 PM on Tuesday, May 27, 2025**, in the County Commission meeting room, located on the second floor of the Lafayette County Courthouse.

This project consists of but is not limited to resurfacing CR 320 from CR 300 to US 27. Major items of work will be temporary traffic control, erosion control, earthwork, milling, asphalt paving, signs and pavement marking, and sodding.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a 5% bid bond with bid submittal, and if selected, furnish the Clerk's office with a payment and performance bond and proof of liability insurance prior to commencing work.

The County reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to add to the contract or delete from the contract to stay within their funding capabilities and award the contract in the best interest of the County.
