MCCRAY GRADE BID RESULTS



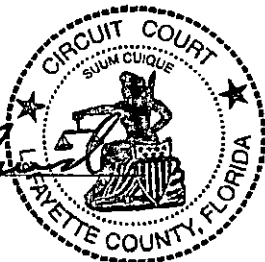


