The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a special meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioner's meeting room in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Henry McCray, Dist. 2 (by phone); Commissioner Lisa Walker, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. DISCUSS THE CORONAVIRUS AND A STATE OF EMERGENCY

The Board discussed the Coronavirus Pandemic and its effect on Lafayette County with Marc Land, EOC Director. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to close all of the community centers throughout the county until April 27, 2020 for rental to the public. On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to declare a state of emergency. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to approve Resolution No. 2020-03-03. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to close the Edward Perry Sports Complex and the First District playground until further notice.

MOVE THE BOARD MEETINGS TO THE COURTROOM

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to move the Board meetings to the Courtroom until further notice and to give the Department Heads the option to submit reports for their updates as opposed to being present at the meeting.
