

REGULAR MEETING

JULY 13, 2020

9:00 A.M.

The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioners Meeting Room at the Lafayette County Courthouse in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Henry McCray, Dist. 2; Commissioner Lisa Walker, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; Commissioner Earnest L. Jones, Dist. 5; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

APPROVE THE MINUTES

On a motion by Mr. McCray and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

TERRY FOLSOM – LAND ISSUE

Terry Folsom and Juan Ceron discussed a land issue with the Board, and what their options were in relation to the Land Development Regulations. The Board told Mr. Robert Hinkle, Building Inspector, to research what they were talking about, to work with both Mr. Folsom and Mr. Ceron, and come up with a resolution for this, before bringing it back before the Board for further review or approval.

REQUEST TO PURCHASE DUMPSTERS

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. McCray, the Board voted unanimously to approve the purchase of a mix load of various dumpsters for the Solid Waste Department.

REQUEST TO PURCHASE CARRY-ALL TRUCK

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to allow Scott Sadler, Public Works Director, to research and purchase a carry-all truck off of the Florida Surplus Materials website for the Solid Waste Department.

HIRE BUILDING DEPARTMENT ASSISTANT

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. Jones, the Board voted unanimously to approve the recommendation and hire Victoria Blanton as the Building Department Assistant.

SET A PUBLIC HEARING FOR ZONING EXEMPTION

The Board agreed to set a Public Hearing on July 27, 2020 at 5:30 p.m. for a Zoning Exemption on behalf of Elvoy Land.

OPEN BIDS FOR NW SUMTER AVENUE

The Board opened the following sealed bids for the NW Sumter Avenue SCOP Improvement project: Anderson Columbia Co., Inc. - \$435,744.52; and Curt's Construction - \$518,176.31. On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. McCray, the Board voted unanimously to approve the low bid, pending the review and approval of Dewberry Engineers, as the Design Engineer for this project.

OPEN BIDS FOR SIMS FARM CHEMICAL SITE PREP

The Board opened a sealed bid for the chemical site prep at the Sims Farm from Southern Helicopter in the amount of \$116.75/acre. On a motion by Mr. McCray and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to award the bid to Southern Helicopter as the sole bidder.

COVID-19 STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATIONS

On a motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mr. McCray, the Board voted unanimously to continue with the State of Emergency Declarations throughout the Covid-19 pandemic.
