SMALL BUSINESS ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM

Commissioner Adams opened the workshop and welcomed everyone to the meeting. Nicole Acosta representing Thomas, Howell and Ferguson, C.P.A. gave the Board an update on Lafayette County's Small Business Application. The application will be available to businesses on September 8, 2020 at the Clerk of Court's Office. Ms. Acosta discussed several issues with the Board. The Board chose to include businesses in the program that received less than \$25,000 in funds covered by insurance or reimbursement from the Federal Payroll Protection Program (PPP), EIDL, or Florida Bridge Loan.

INDUSTRIAL PARK TENANT

The Board discussed the vacant building at the Industrial Park. Christy Vervisch informed the Board that her business (Country Strong Gym) and Andrew Bass would like to share the building. The Board discussed several issues that would need to be addressed since the building was designed for manufacturing.
