

REGULAR MEETING  
FEBRUARY 28, 2022  
5:30 P.M.

The Lafayette County Commission met on the above date and hour for a regular scheduled meeting. The meeting was held in the County Commissioners Meeting Room at the Lafayette County Courthouse in Mayo, Florida. The following members were present: Commissioner Lance Lamb, Dist. 1; Commissioner Henry McCray, Dist. 2; Commissioner Lisa Walker, Dist. 3; Commissioner Anthony Adams, Dist. 4; and Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, County Attorney.

### **OPEN THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENTS MEETING**

#### **CONSIDER RESOLUTION NO. BA V 22-01**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to have Mrs. McMillan read Resolution No. BA V 22-01 by title only. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Resolution for Thomas and Cynthia Fernald to decrease their front yard setbacks from 50 feet to 41 feet, and to allow a decrease of the east side setback from 20 feet to 10 feet.

#### **CONSIDER RESOLUTION NO. BA V 22-02**

On a motion by Mr. McCray and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to have Mrs. McMillan read Resolution No. BA V 22-02 by title only. On a motion by Mr. McCray and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Resolution for Julya Flores-Johnson to allow a decrease of the north and south side yard setback from 50 feet to 33 feet.

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. McCray, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn the Board of Adjustments meeting.

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

## **EARL SUBER – CITIZEN COMPLAINT**

Earl Suber came before the Board to express his concerns about young individuals riding ATV's carelessly on NW Oakland Way. He is concerned about someone being hurt because of this. The Board, after hearing him express his concerns, said that they would take this into consideration to see what they can do to help him. Sheriff Lamb also said that he would speak with them to see what he can do.

## **HIRING OF COLLECTION SITE ATTENDANT AND A SUB**

Mr. Scott Sadler recommended tabling the hiring of a collection site attendant and sub for the Landfills until a later meeting for him to be able to contact both applicants about the position. On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. McCray, the Board voted unanimously to table this issue.

## **CONSIDER A RESOLUTION FOR BUILDING DEPARTMENT PERMITTING PROCEDURES**

On a motion by Mrs. Walker and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to table considering a Resolution that requires a survey prior to permitting for all new development in the County to the next meeting.

## **PUBLIC HEARING – SECOND READING OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 2022-02-01**

The Board held a Public Hearing for the second reading of a proposed ordinance regulating the deposit of specific waste at county collection sites. On a motion by Mr. McCray and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to have Mrs. McMillan-Fredriksson read the proposed ordinance by title only. After asking for public comments, and none being heard, on a motion by Mr. McCray and a second by Mr. Lamb, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the Ordinance.

**APPOINT A MEMBER TO THE SUWANNEE RIVER ECONOMIC COUNCIL  
BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mrs. Walker, the Board voted unanimously to re-appoint Mr. Jimmy Witt to the Suwannee River Economic Council Board of Directors.

**APPROVE THE BILLS**

On a motion by Mr. Lamb and a second by Mr. McCray, the Board voted unanimously to approve following bills:

General Fund - \$232,050.38  
Emergency 911 Fund - \$1,080.83  
Special Account Grants Fund - \$37,157.45  
Courthouse Renovation/Construction Fund - \$3,815.62
